400 Honey Ale

Local wildflower honey adds sweet floral notes to the lightly toasted Wisconsin malt character of this golden ale. Brewed since 1996, this beer is named after the famous C&NW '400' passenger train that kept the Green Bay depot buzzing for decades.

Lakefront IPA

Pours a hazy orange with a rocky white head that lasts and leaves soft lace on your glass as you sip this refreshing beer. American Cascade and Chinook hops dominate the aroma, yielding a citrusy, floral bouquet.

The hops give a nice bitter bite to the flavor, but this beer is surprisingly well balanced with a full body and smooth malty flavor to back up the hops. It finishes smooth and crisp with a lingering hop flavor reminiscent of fresh ruby red grapefruit.
